PAYMENT POLICY

In order to help us maintain our high standards of care, all services are treated as cash transactions. We, as a local family-owned business, are not in a position to provide financing, therefore, your account is due on the day arrangements are made. We accept personal checks, Visa, Mastercard, Discover, American Express, and life insurance assignments. In the event the decedent's funds are not immediately available, a member of the family will need to take care of payment and file their own claim for reimbursement with the estate.

CASH ADVANCES

Cash advances are used for any goods and services that the funeral home purchases from a third party on behalf of the family. Prices will be shown on your statement of funeral goods and services. Cash advances include but are not limited to: certified copies of death certificates, state medical examiners fee (for cremations), disposition permits, cemetery fees, crematory fees, obituary charges, flowers, honorariums, and monument engraving.

This list does not include prices for certain items you may ask us to buy for you, such as cemetery or crematory services, flowers, and newspaper notices. The prices for those items will be shown on your bill or the statement as cash advances describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

Basic Services of the Funeral Director & Staff . . \$1,695.00

Our basic service fee includes, but is not limited to: staff to process and respond to initial request for service anytime; shelter of the deceased for up to 48 hours until the public memorial, funeral activity or final disposition; arrangement conference and consulting with family or other responsible parties; arrangement of the funeral or memorial tribute; preparing, recording and filing legally required documents and vital statistics; preparation and placement of obituary notices in newspapers and funeral home website (Book of Memories); and coordinating final disposition with those providing other portions of the funeral such as cemetery, crematory, clergy, fraternal organizations, vault companies and others as required. This fee for our basic services and overhead is non-declinable and will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials and forwarding or receiving the deceased.)

Embalming \$550.00

Except in certain special cases (see below) embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a service with a viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as immediate burial or direct cremation. Most common carriers require embalming and it is usually necessary for all foreign transfers.

It is our firm's policy to request either embalming or a sealed casket if the body is going to be present for indoor memorial activities, whether viewed or not.

We highly recommend embalming when the deceased is going to be dressed, when the deceased is going to be viewed, and when the deceased is going to be entombed.

IMMEDIATE BURIAL

This is a direct burial option (no funeral rites or ceremonies) and the final cost depends on the casket or container you select.

Charges include: basic services of the funeral director and staff, local transfer of deceased to our facility, temperature controlled care, and local transportation to cemetery.

When you provide a suitable container or casket. . . . \$2,685.00

When you select a casket from our funeral home. . . . \$2,685.00 plus casket

DIRECT CREMATION

This charge for Direct Cremation includes: basic services of funeral director and staff, transfer of deceased to the funeral home, temperature controlled care, and service vehicle to crematory.

Other services of funeral director and staff, use of facilities for viewing, rites or ceremonies (public or private) prior to cremation and any cash advanced items are not included.

NOTE: This does not include fee for crematory or necessary permits.

You are not required to purchase a casket for a Direct Cremation, but you may do so if you wish. If you want to arrange a Direct Cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard, heavy cardboard or composition materials (with or without outside covering and no fixed interior lining).

NOTE: All containers must be leak-proof with a rigid, combustible bottom.

FORWARDING AND RECEIVING OF REMAINS

Forwarding Deceased to Another Funeral Home \$3000.00

This charge includes: a portion of our basic services of the funeral director and staff (\$910.00), local transfer of deceased to our facility (\$395.00), embalming (\$550.00), cosmetology, grooming and dressing (\$250.00), and local transfer of deceased to Logan Airport in Boston (\$895.00).

NOTE: This charge does not include: cash advances, merchandise, optional use of facilities, staff and equipment for viewing and/or a funeral ceremony, and other preparation of deceased if necessary.

Receiving Deceased from Another Funeral Home . . . \$2,450.00

This charge includes: a portion of our basic services of funeral director and staff (\$910.00), transfer of deceased to our facility from Logan Airport in Boston (\$895.00), cosmetology and grooming when receiving deceased for viewing (\$250.00), and local transportation of deceased to the place of final disposition (\$395.00).

NOTE: This charge does not include: cash advances, merchandise, optional use of facilities, staff and equipment for viewing and/or funeral ceremony, or other preparation of deceased if necessary.
